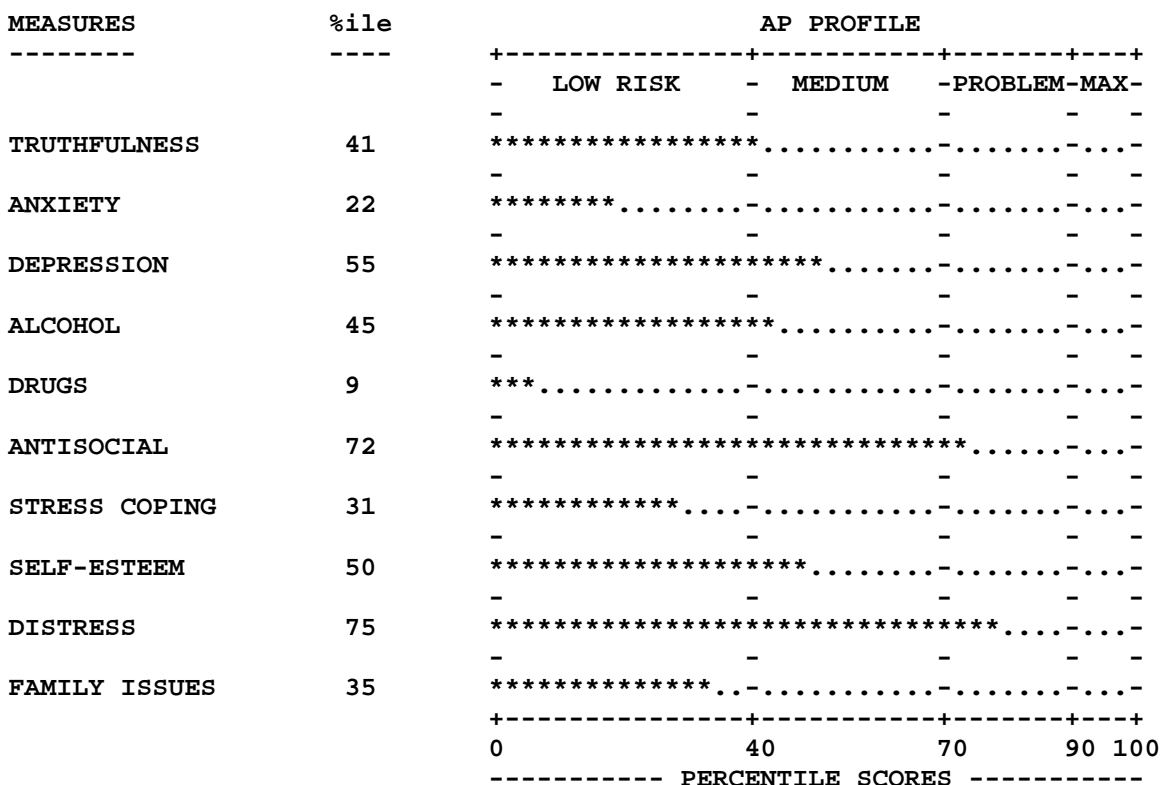

TRUTHFULNESS SCALE: MEDIUM RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:41  
This adults's score on the Truthfulness Scale is in the Medium Risk (40 to 69th percentile) range. This is an accurate Adult Profile profile. However, there is a tendency for this person to deny common problems and to portray self in an overly favorable light. Specific questions will usually be answered more accurately than open ended or general type questions. This probationer has adequate reading skills. This is an accurate profile and other Adult Profile scale scores are accurate.

ANXIETY SCALE: LOW RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:22  
This adult's score on the Anxiety Scale is in the Low Risk (zero to 39th percentile) range. Few symptoms of anxiety, apprehension, tension or pressure are indicated. In counseling settings, anxiety and depression represent the most commonly reported symptoms of distress. This adult reports a low anxiety level. This is a low risk Anxiety Scale score.

DEPRESSION SCALE: MEDIUM RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:55  
This adult's score on the Depression Scale is in the Medium Risk (40 to 69th percentile) range. Some feelings of depression are indicated. Anxiety may also contribute to this probationer's overall adjustment problem. These two symptoms of distress --anxiety and depression-- represent an area for additional inquiry in interview. This is a medium risk Depression Scale score.

ALCOHOL SCALE: MEDIUM RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:45  
This adult's Alcohol Scale score is in the Medium Risk (40 to 69th percentile) range. Some indicators of alcohol (beer, wine or liquor) use are present, however, an established pattern of alcohol abuse is not evident. Alcohol-related problems are likely not focal issues. Referral for alcohol-related treatment does not appear to be warranted at this time. However, a court history of alcohol-related problems, e.g., DUI or DWI would upgrade treatment recommendations.

DRUGS SCALE: LOW RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:9  
This probationer's score on the Drugs Scale is in the Low Risk (zero to 39th percentile) range. Few, if any, significant indicators of illicit drug use or abuse are evident. Drug use, if present, may be historical, experimental in nature or represent minimal involvement. Drugs refers to marijuana (pot), cocaine (coke), downers, crack, amphetamines, barbiturates, heroin, etc. A probationer not using drugs may score above zero, but would still be in the low risk range. This is a low risk Drugs Scale score.

ANTISOCIAL SCALE: PROBLEM RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:72  
An established pattern of antisocial thinking and attitude is evident. Problem Risk is characterized by many antisocial attitudes and behaviors as well as difficulty maintaining responsible relationships and loyalties. These probationers are frequently callous, irresponsible and lack a foundation of mutual affection or trust. Many are boastful, deceitful and given to tantrums or outbursts of rage. Poor work histories, nonpayment of bills and difficulty conforming to social norms are common. With regard to the Antisocial Scale, this probationer attained a Problem Risk score.

STRESS COPING SCALE: LOW RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:31  
 This adult's score on the Stress Coping Abilities Scale is in the Low Risk (zero to 39th percentile) range. Good stress coping abilities are indicated. Low risk scorers cope very well with the stress and pressure they experience. Effective coping skill and stress management do not appear to be problems in this adults's overall adjustment. This person copes well with stress.

SELF-ESTEEM SCALE: MEDIUM RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:50  
 This adult's score on the Self-Esteem Scale is in the Medium Risk (40 to 69th percentile) range. Average self-esteem is indicated. This probationer's self-appraisal or self-esteem is generally positive. Self-esteem incorporates an attitude of acceptance--approval versus rejection--disapproval of oneself. Self-esteem ratings are descriptive of the person one believes oneself to be. This is a medium risk Self-Esteem Scale score.

DISTRESS SCALE: LOW RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:75  
 This adult's Distress Scale score is in the Problem Risk (70 to 89th percentile) range. Problem risk scores typically reflect considerable worry, apprehension and unhappiness. This is a troubled person. Feelings of dependency and suicidal ideation should be explored in interview. Other areas of inquiry might include this person's life situation, adjustment and emotional equilibrium. This person is experiencing considerable distress and is not coping with it well.

FAMILY ISSUES SCALE: LOW RISK RANGE RISK PERCENTILE:35  
 This person's score on the Family Scale is in the Low Risk (zero to 39th percentile) range. Low risk scorers typically perceive their family relationships as harmonious and conflict free. They value the family unit and family homeostasis. This probationer would agree that the environment in which we live is much more than a physical world; it consists of close interpersonal interaction within the family group.

SIGNIFICANT ITEMS:These answers are the client's self-reported responses and they represent direct admissions or unusual responses which may help in understanding the client's situation.
